Mail your order form, along with your payment to Atlanta Audubon Society, 4055 Roswell Road, Atlanta, Georgia 30342 or fax to 770-993-9579 (must call this number first before faxing). Your order AND your payment must be at the AAS office by Tuesday, October 5 at noon.

Pick up your seed on the "Seed Pick-Up Day" on Saturday, October 16, 10AM to 2PM. If you can't get your seed on the pick-up day, you will be charged a \$5 handling charge. If you can't pick up your seed on October 16, it can be picked up during the week; however, you must call the office first to arrange a pick up time since office hours are limited.

Note: *The mice may help themselves to your seed if it is not picked up right away!*

Safflower: Safflower is a lifesaver for those having trouble with squirrels. Most squirrels and blackbirds don't like it, while cardinals, nuthatches and chickadees can't resist it.

Sunflower Meats: This is pure sunflower and the birds' number one choice. With almost no shell, you get more feed for the pound and no messy hulls to pick up.

Oil Sunflower: These sunflowers are the absolute highest quality out there. It's over 99% pure and cleaned four times to ensure that you get more seed and fewer sticks. This is a great seed to attract many great birds.

Niger Seed: Niger seed is a favorite of beautiful wild finches like the American Goldfinch. It is best used in a specifically designed tubular feeder with small holes where it can be economically dispensed.

Finch Friends: Finch Friends is the only finch mix developed for use in a regular tubular feeder. Attracts goldfinches, purple finches and pine siskins. The mix includes sunflower meats, niger seed and canary seed.

White Millet: This is the number one choice of towhees, juncos, song sparrows and doves. Throw it directly on the ground or mix with other seeds. Indigo Buntings also seem to like this mix!

Whole Peanuts (2 bags per order): This fun and nutritious treat attracts titmice, woodpeckers, jays, wrens and many cute critters. Peanuts come in the shell.

Blue Ribbon Blend Suet (12 per case): A great all-purpose suet that attracts the largest variety of songbirds.
